


'Honest It's Crochet' Cowl



- No seaming
- Reversible
- Full instructions with photos
- UK crochet terminology



Approx. Tension:

8sts x 10 rounds = 10cm x 10cm
8sts x 10 rounds = 4" x 4"


Materials:

2 x Woolcraft Luxury Soft Chunky with Alpaca 100g /150m
Main colour: Shade 940 Dark Grey


1 x Woolcraft Luxury Soft Chunky with Alpaca 100g /150m
Contrast colour: Shade 06 Light Grey

9mm crochet hook
Removable stitch marker
Large darning needle
Scissors


Abbreviation	Meaning	Directions
yo	yarn over	wrap yarn over hook from back to front
ch	chain	yo and draw through the loop on the hook
sl st	slip stitch	insert hook into stitch/chain from front to back, yo, draw loop through all loops on hook
htr	halftreble	yo, insert hook into stitch/chain from front to back, yo, draw loop back through (3 loops on hook), yo, draw loop through all 3 loops on hook.
camel-htr	camel halftreble	yo, roll top of stitch towards you & insert hook into 3 rd loop from front to back, yo, draw loop back through (3 loops on hook), yo, draw loop through all 3 loops on hook.
colour change camel-htr	camel halftreble with a change of yarn colour	yo, roll top of stitch towards you & insert hook into 3 rd loop from front to back, yo, draw loop back through (3 loops on hook), drop the old colour yarn, yo with the new colour yarn, draw loop through all 3 loops on hook.



From the right side of the work the 3rd loop is just visible between the posts of the stitches.



From the wrong side of the work the 3rd loops are clearly visible.



Camel htr: Roll top of stitch towards you and work into the 3rd loop.

Foundation Chain:

Using Main Colour: Ch 130. Turn.

Set Up Round:

Work 1 htr into the 1st foundation ch stitch. (There is no need to work a turning chain, simply work the htr directly into the chain stitch.)

Place a marker in the top of this stitch – this will be the start of round marker.

Work 1 htr into each stitch of the foundation chain. Do not turn the work.

Ensuring your work is not twisted, camel-htr into the htr stitch that has the marker in it to form a circle. Move the marker up into this new stitch.

(The gap in the work will be closed up at the end when weaving in the yarn tails.)

Pattern Rounds:

You will be working in a continuous spiral. Do not turn the work at the end of a round. Move the marker up as you work.

- Work 4 spiral rounds in Main Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

Work a colour change camel-htr to change to Contrast Colour. Leaving a 10cm tail, cut the Main Colour yarn.

- Work 3 spiral rounds in Contrast Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

Work a colour change camel-htr to change to Main Colour. Leaving a 10cm tail, cut the Contrast Colour yarn.

- Work 2 spiral rounds in Main Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

Work a colour change camel-htr to change to Contrast Colour. Leaving a 10cm tail, cut the Main Colour yarn.

- Work 1 spiral rounds in Contrast Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker.

- Work 2 spiral rounds in Main Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

- Work 3 spiral rounds in Contrast Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

Work a colour change camel-htr to change to Main Colour. Leaving a 10cm tail, cut the Contrast Colour yarn.

- Work 5 spiral rounds in Main Colour, working 1 camel-htr into each stitch of the previous round. Stop 1 stitch before the marker on the final round.

Roll top of stitch towards you & insert hook into 3rd loop from front to back,
yo, draw loop back through (2 loops on hook),
yo, draw loop through both loops on hook.

Slip stitch into the next stitch. Leaving a 10cm tail, cut the yarn and fasten off.

- Weave in yarn ends. Close gap at beginning of work by making a figure 8 with the yarn tail across the gap as you weave in the ends.
